**SELF CERTIFICATION FORM

Existing Single-Family dwellings shall be provided with Smoke Detector and Carbon Monoxide Alarms (Senate Bill No. 1394 Chapter 420). When the valuation of additions, alterations, or repairs to dwelling unit exceeds \$1,000.00, Section(s) R314 and R315 of the 2016 California Residential Code that Smoke Alarms and Carbon Monoxide Alarms must be installed in the following locations:

1. In each sleeping room.
 - Smoke Alarm (*Carbon Monoxide Alarm* also required in bedroom(s) containing fuel-fire appliance or fireplace*)
2. Outside each separate sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of the bedroom(s).
 - Smoke Alarm and Carbon Monoxide Alarm*
3. On each additional story of the dwelling unit, including basements and habitable attics.
 - Smoke Alarm and Carbon Monoxide Alarm*

Combination Detectors: Smoke detectors combined with Carbon Monoxide Alarms shall comply with Section R315.6.4 and shall be approved by the Office of the State Fire Marshal.

Power Supply: In dwelling units with no commercial power supply, alarm(s) may be solely battery operated. In existing dwelling units, alarms are permitted to be solely battery operated where repairs or alternations do not result in the removal of interior walls, ceiling finishes or there is no access by means of attic, basement or crawl space. See Sections R314.6 and R315.5. An electrical permit is required for alarms which must be connected to the building wiring.

*** Carbon Monoxide Alarms:** Are not required in dwellings which do not contain fuel-burning appliances or fireplaces (fuel-burning) and that do not have an attached garage with an opening that communicates with the dwelling unit.

As owner of the above-referenced property, I hereby certify that the alarm(s) referenced above has/have been installed in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and in compliance with the California Residential Code. The alarms have been tested and are operational.

This certification must be returned to the Building Inspector prior to final inspection approval of all building permits requiring compliance with SB 1394 Chapter 420.
