Dear Administrator Roberts:

Earlier this week, Mountain View received numerous communications from concerned residents alerting the City to what they interpret as proposed plans by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to implement changes to the Class B airspace that would shift airplane noise and negatively affect communities along the Peninsula, including the City of Mountain View. It is our understanding that the deadline to respond to these proposed changes is today, November 8, 2017.

The proposed changes have created confusion and consternation within our communities, and additional information and clarity regarding these changes is required to ensure that concerned residents have complete, accurate, and easily understandable information. We respectfully request and urge the FAA to extend the deadline for public comment to allow impacted communities and residents an opportunity to receive an explanation of the actions proposed and to provide feedback to the FAA.
