RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR USE OF SPECIFIC PARK AREAS FOR OFF-LEASH DOG TRAINING

1. Off-Leash Permit Card must be in owner's immediate possession while dog training.
2. Use of the designated areas are for formal dog training purposes only.
3. Formal dog training does not include free play or any activity such as fetch which allows the dog to run freely.
4. All training must be confined to specified areas designated by the Recreation Manager.
5. Training shall be limited to obedience training only. Attack or protection-type training is prohibited.
6. No training is permitted on legal holidays.
7. Training is limited to normal park hours—6:00 a.m. to one-half hour after sundown.
8. Cleaning up after your dog is mandatory! Deposit waste in trash container or take it with you.
9. Dog must be under control at all times, on or off leash.
10. All vaccinations must be current. Certification of vaccination must be submitted with the application form.
11. The Recreation Division reserves the right to cancel training areas, without notice, when park areas are used for other activities conducted by the City.
12. Permit may be revoked by the Recreation Manager upon a showing of misuse.
13. Dogs in heat prohibited.

I have read and understand the rules governing the use of the facilities and agree to abide by them. I also understand that if I fail to observe the regulations, I may be denied future use of the facilities.
