A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOUNTAIN VIEW
RATIFYING PROCLAMATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 11.6 of Article I of Chapter 11 of the City of Mountain View City Code authorizes the Director of Emergency Services to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency when the City is affected, or likely to be affected, by a public calamity and the City Council is not in session; and

WHEREAS, an incident giving rise to significant public health and safety concerns arose in the City of Mountain View from a City Contractor's contamination of City water lines that required water service to approximately 67 homes near Cuesta Park to be shut off beginning April 24, 2026, at approximately 1:00 p.m ("Water Main Incident"); and

WHEREAS, on Saturday, April 25, 2026, the City Manager, in her capacity as the Director of Emergency Services, issued a proclamation of local emergency (**Exhibit A**) in the City of Mountain View as a result of the Water Main Incident because City Council was not in session at that time and immediate action was necessary to preserve the City's ability to access any available financial or other assistance from county, state, and federal agencies in response to the incident; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11.6 of Article I of Chapter 11 of the City of Mountain View City Code City, the City Council must ratify the Director's proclamation within seven (7) days, or it will expire; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: that the City Council of the City of Mountain View hereby ratifies the Proclamation of Local Emergency issued by the Director of Emergency Services on April 25, 2026; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that said proclamation shall remain in full force and effect until its termination is declared by the Director of Emergency Services.

FURTHER RESOLVED: that this resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

PROCLAMATION OF THE EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY


WHEREAS, Section 11.6 of Article I, Chapter 11 of the City of Mountain View City Code authorizes the Director of Emergency Services to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency when the City is affected, or likely to be affected, by a public calamity and the City Council is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Emergency Services for the City of Mountain View hereby finds that:

1. Conditions of extreme peril to the health and safety of persons have arisen within the City due to actions of a City contractor that caused a contamination breach in a City water main, requiring the shutoff of water service to approximately 67 homes near Cuesta Park beginning on or about April 24, 2026, at approximately 1:00 p.m.; and
2. The City Council of the City of Mountain View is not in session and cannot immediately be called into session.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED that a local emergency now exists in the affected area surrounding Cuesta Park in the City of Mountain View.

IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that, during the existence of said local emergency, the powers, functions, and duties of the emergency organization of this City shall be those prescribed by state law and by the ordinances and resolutions of this City.
